

Brevard Rescue Mission works to permanently break the cycle of homelessness in families by providing homeless women with children: housing, access to health care, transportation, education, nutrition, job training and life skills in a safe, Christ-centered residential setting.

This long term program is designed to lovingly transform families from dependency to self-sufficiency through daily accountability, personal responsibility and goal advancement.

STABILIZE



Provide crisis intervention and meet immediate housing and healthcare needs

STRATEGIZE



Create a plan for her educational goals and kids' learning and behavioral needs

STRENGTHEN



Offer encouragement, guidance, supportive life skills and Bible study

SEND FORTH



Prepare her for completion of the BRM program and independent living

SUSTAIN





Follow up with the families for the first six months and beyond as needed to ensure success

FAMILIES! This year, we officially purchased — debt-free — a 1.7 acre lot with 13 buildings which will become BRM's headquarters!

Ideally located just south of the intersection of US1 and Eau Gallie Blvd, this will expand our program to serve not only eight additional families, but also open our services to non-resident families. We will be able to provide one-on-one case management and referrals as well as group life skills classes for struggling families - with the goal to help PREVENT them from becoming homeless!

NEW HOPE & NEW LIFE



When Tiffany's daughter became seriously ill, requiring a feeding tube and round-theclock care, this mom had no choice but to quit her job and care for her child. With no other income, they were forced out of their home and sought temporary shelter with a friend.

Overwhelmed and desperate for a miracle, she received a call from Brevard Rescue Mission that they were accepted into the program. "My eyes filled with tears," said Tiffany. "We were on the verge of sleeping in our car."

"She was fully committed to working the program and learning needed life skills," said her Case Manager. "I watched her faith and trust in Christ grow through Bible study classes, which helped all of the other elements fall into place."

Tiffany graduated from BRM with a full-time job and her own two-bedroom apartment. "BRM has changed my life for the better," explained Tiffany. "What I learned there will last my entire lifetime and I'm teaching it to my daughter too so she will be successful when she grows up!"





We have established a strong foundation to include a six-month operating cash reserve, an endowment at the Community Foundation for Brevard and an active Planned Giving Program.
