Dear Friends,

Have you ever seen a time-lapse video of a seed from the moment it's planted to the moment it breaks through the surface and turns its leaves upward to the sun? The journey of every seedling is unique depending on its type, variety and the availability of nutrient support.

The same is true for the families in our program.

When a homeless mom calls our intake line or fills out an online application, she receives the individualized resources she needs, based on her unique circumstances, to move her family out of their current situation.

The seeds of hope are planted.

In our program, each mother has access to safe housing, one-on-one case management, counseling, parenting support, weekly Bible studies, life skills classes, educational guidance, financial coaching and employment assistance. Her children receive enriching childcare, tutoring, and healthy socializing through planned activities.

Families are tended to and loved.

Our moms work through a 4-phase program: Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, Senior. Each milestone and level completion is celebrated whether it's receiving a GED, paying down family debt, enrolling in a certificate program, earning a

driver's license or receiving an offer for full-time employment.

We harvest the blessings.

But we're never done planting seeds!

This year marks 15 years of transforming the lives of mothers and children who have experienced homelessness in Brevard County. In the next year we will open our fourth campus known as The Village, launch a new Kids Academy childcare center, and grow our social enterprise, the Transformed Shop.

Most importantly, we will expand our capacity to serve even more families and 100% of those family members will hear the truth of the Gospel.

This annual report highlights some of the statistics from the past year, and there are even more blessings that occur daily on all of our campuses.

Thank you for continuing to plant and tend with us on this journey. The seeds we're sowing together will provide a harvest of blessings for years to come!

STORY OF

BREAKTHROUGH



With tears in her eyes, "Brittany" whispered, "I don't know what it means to love myself anymore. I attended a high school in this area and had dreams of becoming successful and traveling the country. I wanted more for myself. But life happened."

Brittany endured several unfulfilling relationships that promised love but never delivered. She soon became a single, homeless mother to four children without a place to go. She constantly worried about how she would get enough money to buy food and gas for the car they slept in. She wanted to give her children a better childhood than the one she had.

"My children deserve to have a safe home, go to school, and have fun. I lost myself years ago, but I came to New Life Mission to give them more."

As a freshman in the program, Brittany has embraced the sisterhood of the other women. She is attending weekly church services, is enrolled in college classes, and is working at a local daycare.

On Tuesdays and Saturdays, Brittany's children attend Kids Club to learn about the Bible and enjoy nutritious meals, make crafts, and play games. They also participate in exciting activities shared by volunteer church and community groups. This summer her teenagers attended East Coast Christian Center's Youth Camp, while her younger children

participated in Brevard Zoo's Family Nature Club and Family TaeKwon-Do at Casa Carol.

"This program is giving my children opportunities that I never had growing up. For the first time, I can focus on being their mom instead of worrying about food and a place to sleep. New Life Mission allows my kids to be children a gain!"

As Brittany continues to see her children thrive at New Life Mission, she can begin to love herself more. She can be proud of the mother she is becoming, and the many opportunities that are being planted for them all.

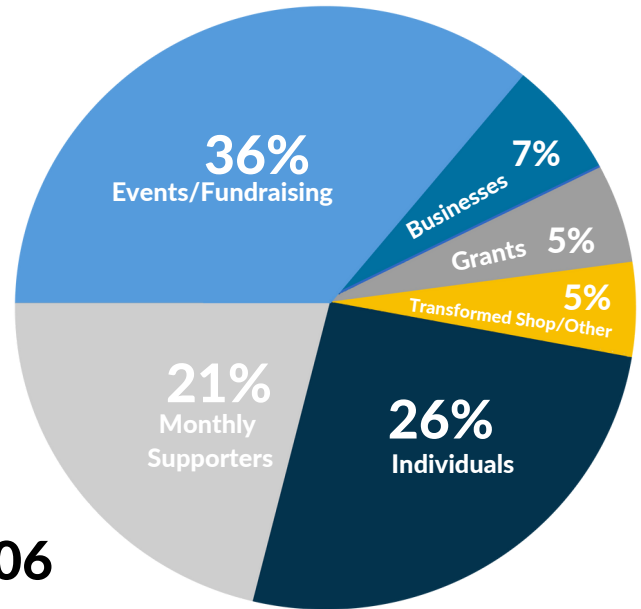

We believe that providing the basic needs of food, shelter and clothing is just a start to address the root causes of homelessness. Our families come from backgrounds of childhood trauma, abuse, addiction, domestic violence and generational poverty. We have found that the greatest success comes when they are welcomed into an nourishing environment of community, grace and education.

Most importantly, we believe healing happens when families are introduced to the ultimate healer, Jesus Christ.

Through customized case management and financial coaching, we strive to educate, empower and equip each family as they journey through the levels of our program. Together, we celebrate family transformation that lasts generations!

This year so many volunteers helped with renovations at our newest property, New Life Village. From yard work, tree trimming, painting and construction, this new location is on target to open in Fall of 2022.

VOLUNTEERS

541 Volunteers supported us with 4,327 donated hours
