WHO WE SERVE

Homeless women with children find New Life Mission by searching the Internet, or as a referral from a friend, church or other service provider. The circumstances that bring families to us vary. This year included rising costs of food, supplies and rent, eviction, addiction, domestic violence, generational poverty, mental health issues, human trafficking, incarceration, death of a family member and financial setbacks.

HOW WE SERVE

With time and space to heal, women and their children reside at one of our four campuses in Melbourne for up to 2 years. Each family receives an individualized case plan and the resources they need to progress through the four phases of the program and become self-sustaining.

The 25-acre Hacienda Girls Ranch was purchased and named New Life Village. Three group-style living homes and a large administrative building gave us room to grow.

With added space and capacity for larger families at New Life Village, we served 53% more children than the year before.




2025

We have established a strong foundation including a six-month operating cash reserve, an endowment at the Community Foundation for Brevard, and an active Planned Giving Program.
