On May 28, five mothers graduated from New Life Mission's ReNewed Life Program, celebrating years of hard work, growth, and perseverance.

After fleeing an abusive relationship with her daughter and a few belongings, **Fabiolla** arrived at New Life seeking safety and a fresh start.

"When I left ... the only thing I had was my little baby and God," Fabiolla said.

Upon moving into The Village, she said the room for herself and her daughter "felt so much like heaven." In May, Fabiolla graduated with a degree in accounting management and will start working at United Way Space Coast.

Before becoming homeless, **Courtney** said **she prayed for a flower, but God gave her a "garden."** Although she was scared upon arriving at The Village in March of 2025, Courtney quickly began making progress towards her goals.

"I got my son into free childcare at New Life Kid's Academy, and he started thriving," Courtney said.

Within months of arriving, Courtney earned her GED, started working, got baptized and received a donated vehicle. After earning her commercial driver's license earlier this year, she will begin her career as a CDL delivery driver for Home Depot this summer.

"Hard work pays off," Courtney said.

In 2024, **Saige** found herself struggling to break free from cycles of abuse, addiction and unhealthy relationships. After coming to New Life, she began pursuing her goal of becoming a Licensed Practical Nurse.

"I am no longer just surviving, I am rebuilding," Saige said. "I am rising into my fullest potential, and **I am walking in the purpose God placed in my life.**"

Serena shared how her dysfunctional

upbringing pulled her into the wrong crowds starting in 5th grade. Caught in an hostile relationship years later, she found herself kicked out of her home and searching for a place to stay.

"I found one right here, New Life Mission, and that is where my journey truly began," Serena said.

Serena is now employed as an insurance sales representative, earning a living for herself and her four young children.

At New Life, **Monica** learned she didn't have to settle. After two years in the program, she found a job she loves and saved up for a new car of her own.

"New Life was a beacon of light for me at the end of a very dark tunnel, and I would like to think now, I've entered the light," Monica said.
